



WHAT IS A RAISED CROSSWALK?

A **raised crosswalk** is at the same level as the sidewalk. It provides a **flat, even surface** to walk across the street. Because it is raised, people crossing the street are **more visible** to drivers.



Slowing down

A

Drivers need to slow and yield to people crossing. All crosswalks are painted with reflective striping, so they are visible at night.

B

People crossing are more visible

Design prevents people from parking too close or on top of crosswalk, which would create a safety hazard

C

Location

Located in front of Senior Center entrance so people with disabilities have easy access to door
