

Auto Shop Permit Checklist

- Occupancy Permit: States what and how a building is to be used. Issued by Inspectional Services Dept. 1010 Massachusetts Ave. 5th Flr. Boston MA 02118.
- Boston Fire Department Flammable Storage License: Required to store vehicles, flammable or combustible materials inside a building (must be renewed annually). 1010 Massachusetts Ave, 4th Floor. (1-617-343-3477)
- **3. Boston Fire Department Annual Permit:** Required permit for rubbish containers, torches, spray paint and spray booths *(must be renewed annually)*.
- **4. Boston Police Licensing Unit:** Class 2 License to sell used vehicles, 1 Schroeder Plaza, Boston Ma. 02120 (1-617-343-4425) *(must be renewed annually)*
- **5. Use of Premises Permit:** Allows for a particular use for open space, area of land. Such as selling or storing vehicles and storage containers.
- **6. Workers Compensation Insurance:** All employers operating in Massachusetts are required to carry worker's compensation insurance for their employees and themselves if they are an employee of their company, some exceptions may apply. *(must be renewed annually.)*1-800-323-3249 X470
- **7. Site Cleanliness License:** Required by all businesses that use bulk dumpsters, must apply to Inspectional Services for a license. *(must be renewed annually)*
- 8. Business Certificate: All businesses require a Business Certificate, from the City Clerk's Office Room 601, 1 City Hall Square, Boston MA 02201. 617-635-4600 (renew every 4 yrs.)
- **9. Inspectional Services Auto Shop License**: All automotive related businesses are required to have this license to operate *(must be renewed annually.)*
- Registered Shop: All motor vehicle auto body and glass repair shops must be registered with the Massachusetts Division of Standards (1-617-727-3480 (renew every 3 yrs.)

*Failure to obtain or renew these licenses/permits may affect your right to operate.
