





Hi all,

Happy to chat this out because it is a little confusing but the <u>South End Landmark District Standards and Criteria</u> (section D.1.c) states the following:

"Several properties within the district have already lost their original or historically correct wood windows. They have been replaced with either aluminum window units or inappropriately designed, poorly constructed and installed wood window units. The commission strongly encourages the replacement of these units with wood windows that meet the standards for window replacement. However, since the original resource has already been lost, and an inappropriate window unit has been since installed, the commission will allow the installation of aluminum replacement window units that meet the Standards and Criteria for window replacement."

From what Gabriela and I saw when we went out the windows would qualify as a "poorly constructed and installed wood window unit" which is why in this instance aluminum is ok.

Most of the time original wood windows or "older wood windows with historic proportions" must be replaced with wood but these windows meet D. 1. c.

I just wanted to follow up with you regarding Kristen's project below. There was a bit of a misunderstanding, and the pictures that Kristen had sent in was from a different project. I've attached pictures of the windows at 84 West Concord that you mentioned you took a look at.

The existing windows are non-original wood exterior windows. In the email below, you mentioned that you had looked at the windows and aluminum would likely be acceptable. Previously when I had inquired about replacing wood exterior windows with aluminum clad windows, you had mentioned that was unacceptable.

I'm looking for a bit of clarity as Kristen would like to replace the windows with aluminum clad windows, but is likely uninterested in replacing the windows at all if they have to remain wood. I would rather not go through the whole process if it is going be something that is clearly unacceptable so I would just ask you for some clarification on your email below as to whether or not aluminum clad would be acceptable or not.

If it is, I'll submit a formal application of course, but if it has to be all wood, I'd like to just save all of us the time, paperwork, and money of contracts and applications.



Hi Rachel,

I am in touch with a window installer about my windows at <u>84 West Concord St Boston</u>. He has been in touch with you too. I got this approval in 2019 for my unit at <u>84 West Concord St, unit 2</u>. I had applied for aluminum

clad black wood windows to replace the replacement windows that are already there (they are old wood replacements with multiple layers of framing that would be stripped down, so the opening could be restored to original size. The building has 6 units and they all have odd and various replacement windows that have been done over the years, including white vinyl (unfortunately), etc.

I am hoping my interpretation of this approval is correct and that our application was approved as-is, as the aluminum cladding would be much more durable, while providing a historical look and style. Its a first floor unit, so I am paying more for Pella to really strip and install new construction type windows, and not just slide in more replacements, and I want to get it right and do something that will look great and really last forever.

Can we use this approval to proceed at this time?
